Position Summary:

The primary role of the home delivery driver position is to operate food bank vans to deliver food and essential non-food items to qualified neighbors in our three-county service area. This role is essential to our mission of providing hunger relief.

Essential Job Functions:

- Load, transport, and delivery of essential items to neighbors who receive delivery on a weekly basis.
- Accurately and timely completion of all deliveries to neighbors.
- Maintain vans by performing daily inspections, cleaning all spills immediately, and washing each
 van at minimum once per month, including cargo area; Notify direct supervisor of maintenance
 issues for proper resolution. Responsible for maintaining excellent relationships with neighbors
 and effectively addressing any issues those receiving their weekly package(s) may express.
- Thoroughly communicate any question, concern, or opinion of neighbors to the direct supervisor that you are not able to address immediately.
- Deliver days package(s) directly to neighbors' door, this involves navigating stairs, steps, elevators, and other common home features.
- Pull frozen and refrigerated product on day of delivery to maintain proper temperature.
- Maintain Food Safety standards by ensuring proper temperature in cargo area during delivery, running the Refrigeration unit as necessary.
- Adhere to assigned routes and assigned rules for safety and procedures.
- Use online GPS and reporting website to document deliveries throughout the workday.
- Learn client intake procedures and assist on mobile and on-site distributions.
- Work with all the Programs team to move identify and distribute short shelf-life donated product to prevent waste.
- Assist in warehouse organization, van loading/unloading, and inventory management. Work with Alley Walk Up team to ensure all donated product is being distributed, limiting waste.
- Participate in food bank events such as Post Office Food Drive and Holiday Food Drive by delivering and retrieving barrels, signage, and coin cans as necessary.
- Delivery of Commodity boxes to senior distribution sites.
- Assistance in warehouse organization and cleanliness.



Reporting:

- Maintain and submit all receipts, fuel, maintenance on daily basis as received.
- Use PantryTrak® and Routific® to record deliveries in real time throughout the workday.
- Provide feedback to direct supervisor on the home delivery program.
- Report any vehicle problems to the direct supervisor immediately.

- Cross trained to other warehouse positions and food bank software.
- Assists with on-site distributions as needed.
- Assists as needed in warehouse team operational coverage.
- Attends meetings, presentations, and trainings as required.
- Complies with and meets departmental goals and objectives.
- Learns, teaches, trains, and adheres to all Feeding America and AIB required standards.
- Receives and maintains ServSafe certification.
- Assists in warehouse organization and cleanliness.
- Works with volunteers and other staff to increase efficiencies of the operation.
- Assists in rapid recognition and resolution of general and food safety issues.
- Provides superior customer service to all neighbors and partner organizations.
- Participates in AIB certification.
- Other duties as assigned.
